HEALTH AND SAFETY INDUCTION FOR WORKERS COURSE

Competency Guidelines

The learning outcomes of this course are aligned with the *Australian National Guidelines for Integrating Occupational Health and Safety into National Industry Training Packages*.

Aims

1. To provide participants with the basic knowledge and skills to contribute to the establishment and maintenance of safe systems of work and injury prevention.
2. To address the key principles of workers compensation and injury management rehabilitation.
3. To assist in the development of appropriate attitudes to enable employees to participate in the prevention of workplace injuries and illnesses.

Objectives

At the completion of the course participants should be able to:

- Identify the key elements of the legislation governing health and safety in NSW workplaces and the role of PCBUs, Officers, Workers and Others.
- Explain the consultative process and discuss the role of the Health and Safety Committee and Health and Safety representative,
- Explain the need for and describe the principles of health and safety Risk Management and how to create safe systems of work,
- Explain the need for and the basics of procedures that deal with emergencies and first aid in the workplace,
- Explain the key principles of worker's compensation and injury management rehabilitation.

Duration 4 hours on-site.
